School Uniform

Dear Parents/Carers and Members of the School Community,

Following several enquiries around jewellery and PE kit, we felt as a school it would be helpful to remind parents/carers of our expectations around uniform as a whole.

Main Uniform

Grey/black trousers/skirts/formal shorts/pinafore
Red polo shirt
Red sweatshirt/cardigan
Grey/black socks/tights
Black or brown shoes (not trainers)

PE Kit

School sweatshirt
White polo shirt or T shirt
Plain black/navy shorts/leggings or joggers
Trainers

Earrings must be removed for PE lessons. (This will come into effect fully from the 6th November) until then we ask you to remove them, or tape them up for your child.

Coat

Please ensure your child comes with a coat -preferably one that is waterproof and has a hood.

Jewellery

A limited number of items of jewellery are permitted in school – these include:

A watch (not a Smartwatch)
Plain stud earrings.
Jewellery worn for religious reasons.

Please note that no bracelets, rings, necklaces should be worn.

All jewellery must be removed for PE; **this does include earrings**. As we stated in earlier communications, if children are unable to remove their earrings, they will not be able to fully take part in a PE lesson.

Please ensure that you remove your child's earrings on their PE days.
