

GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE 2024 - 2025

- Local Governing Committees meet 5 times per year and is clerked by North Yorkshire Council and come under the Scheme of Delegation for Coast and Vale Learning Trust.
- Other working groups can be set up to look at specific projects.
- Governors to be appointed for link roles in line with roles and responsibilities document.
 - 9 Governors is preferable. The principal would be on the governors as Ex-Officio
 - Staff Member (not SLT)
 - 2 parent governors preferable separate dates of ratification to enable continuity
 - 5 Trustee appointed governors at least two of which should be sponsor governors
- Terms of Office are generally 4 years
- Annual appointment of Chair and Vice Chair
- The Chair must be ratified by the Trust Board along with any future appointment of governors
