Year 10 Parents Evening Thursday 10th July 4pm-7pm – Please note, this is in person and will take place on the Scalby School site.

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to invite you and your child to our Y10 Parents' Evening on Thursday 10th July. This Parents Evening is in our calendar to allow you the opportunity to meet with your child's subject teachers and discuss their progress at Scalby. It is essential that you do everything possible to attend this evening.

Your child is about to embark on their most important year in education to date as they approach their GCSE exams. This parents evening will also give you information about the Y10 trial exams that students are currently completing. It is essential in helping prepare students for Y11 as subject teachers will be able to inform you about the upcoming year, and how your child can be successful.

At these meetings, you will have an opportunity to receive feedback on the progress your child is making in their individual subjects. It also an opportunity for you to ask questions too. Please do bear in mind the time with each member of staff is limited to 7 minutes. Timings are very strict to allow as many people as possible to see all the teachers they would like to, with each parent able to book a maximum of 8 appointments.

The school booking system can be found using this link, <https://scalbyschool.schoolcloud.co.uk/>, where you will be able to book and view appointments. To log in, just enter your details and that of your child. The system will be live for booking on Monday 30th June at 17:00 and close on Friday 4th July at 17:00. Bookings are made on a first come first served basis. Unfortunately, some staff may teach more than one Y10 class so they may become fully booked quickly. If this is the case and you would like to speak to that staff member, please feel free to contact them and request an update on the progress of your child.

On the evening, you and your son/daughter should arrive on the school site in good time ready for your meetings. We will provide you with a map showing the location of the teachers for your appointments.

Of course, contact with teachers at Scalby is never limited to parents' evenings; you are always welcome to call or email your child's teachers at any time should you require an update on their progress.
