Dear Parent/ Carer,

We are delighted to be able to welcome our Year 7 students back to the main Scalby site on Monday 22nd April. Initially, the students will be based in the 'Village', with their current members of teaching staff to support them with this transition period.

As you will be aware, our students will have an additional period within the school day, which will be added to their timetable. This will be dedicated to creative curriculum areas such as IT, Music, Drama and PE. Classes that study French will also access additional lessons in this subject.

Friday 19th April

To further support students with the move, on Friday 19th April, selected students will have an enhanced transition process, spending the full day at Scalby School. All remaining students will spend the afternoon of Friday 19th April at Scalby School. The table below sets out the timings of the day.

The SEND team will contact you directly if your child is involved in the enhanced transition process, which will include posting home a Strong Start plan.

8:20- 12:00	Enhanced Transition students will <i>not</i> leave the Scalby site on the buses and will spend their morning at Scalby. All other students will arrive at Scalby, take the bus to the UTC and access lessons as normal. During Mentor time at the Scalby UTC Campus, students will be given their new timetables and a run through of the school day and expectations.
12:30- 1:00	All students will return to Scalby and join the Enhanced Transition students in the canteen for lunch.
1:00- 1:30	Welcome and celebration assembly from Mr Roberston for all students.
1:30- 2:30	Tour of the main site and village for all students.

Catering:

At Scalby, Year 7 pupils will be able to access the school canteen as normal at both breaks and lunch times, and will be able to purchase both hot and cold food.
